

Itinerary: The Golden Triangle – 12 days

Day 1 **Welcome to Accra**

Arrive in Accra, Ghana. Transfer from airport to your hotel. Welcome drink and orientation. Overnight at Hotel in Accra

Day 2 **Accra City Tour**

After breakfast depart hotel for a sightseeing city tour of Accra with the best highlights.

Overnight in Accra

Day 3 **Ada**

Discover the East Coast. A visit to songhor salt mining site, a boat trip to the Ada estuary where the world's biggest manmade lake enters the Atlantic ocean. Overnight at Sogakope

Day 4 **Volta**

Trip to Mid Volta, explore the highest habitation in Ghana and the highest waterfall in West Africa. Overnight in Biakpa Community

Day 5 **Akosombo**

Fun with the sacred Monkeys at Tafi Atome Monkey sanctuary before travelling to Akosombo.

Overnight in Akosombo

Day 6 **Kumasi**

Transfer to Kumasi the capital of the Ashanti Kingdom to explore the legends of the famous Ashantis. On arrival, we shall take a walking tour of the Kejetia market, which is the biggest open market in West Africa.

Overnight in Kumasi

Day 7 **Kumasi/Ashanti culture**

We will visit the Manhyia Palace which is the seat of the Ashanti Kingdom , visit some craft villages and other interesting spots of the Ashanti region.

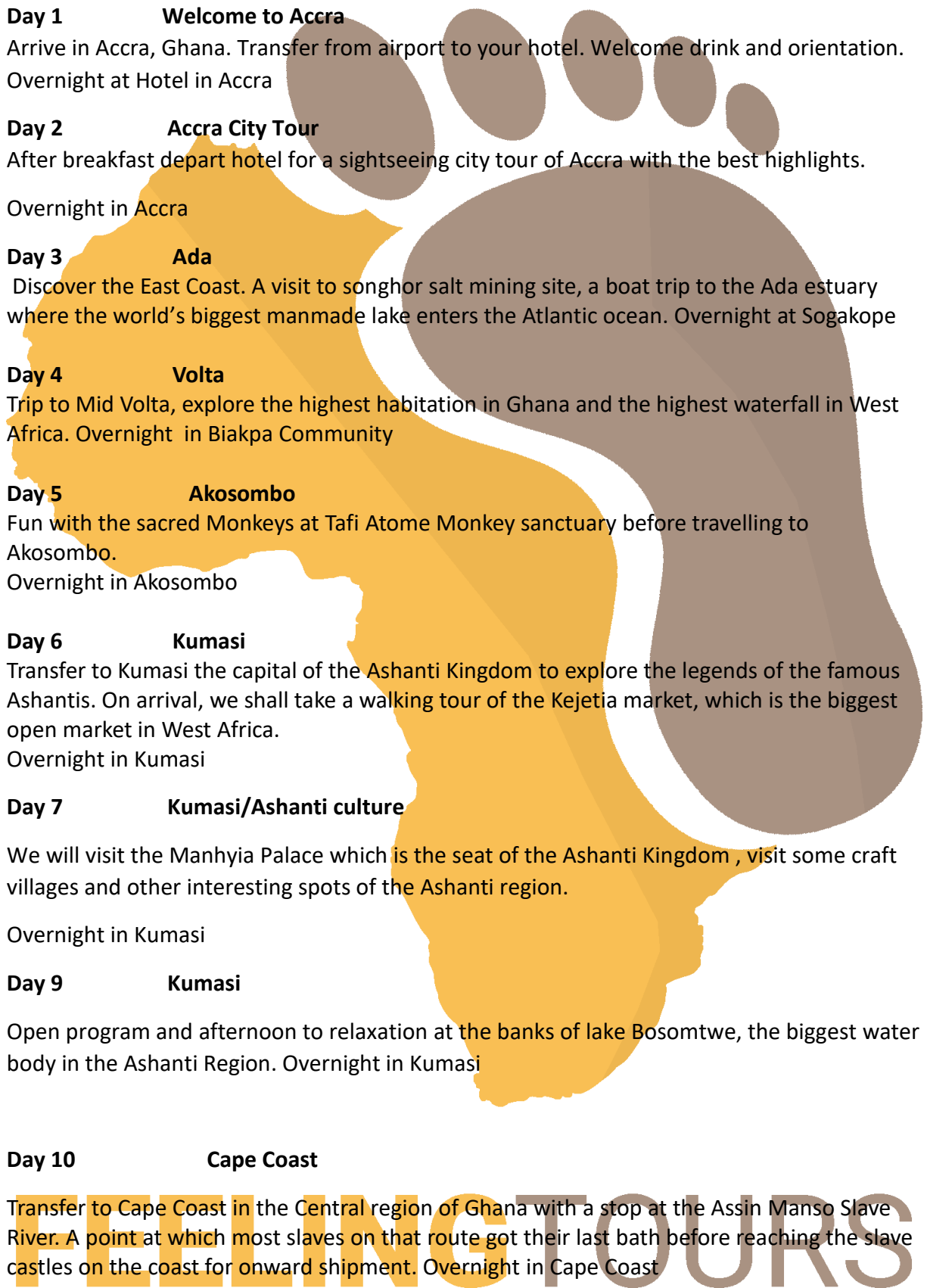
Overnight in Kumasi

Day 9 **Kumasi**

Open program and afternoon to relaxation at the banks of lake Bosomtwe, the biggest water body in the Ashanti Region. Overnight in Kumasi

Day 10 **Cape Coast**

Transfer to Cape Coast in the Central region of Ghana with a stop at the Assin Manso Slave River. A point at which most slaves on that route got their last bath before reaching the slave castles on the coast for onward shipment. Overnight in Cape Coast



Day 11

Kakum National Park/Elmina

Excursion to **Kakum National Park**, one of West Africa's surviving tropical rainforests. Many species of butterflies, flora and fauna. The most popular attraction is the **Canopy walkway** which is made up of seven bridges extending 360m, hanging 40m above the forest floor.

Visit one of the UNESCO heritage sites the Elmina Castle also known as St. Georges Castle built by the Portuguese in 1482. This castle was the first European structure built in Sub – Saharan Africa. A guided tour through this castle and the dungeons will recount the story of the slave trade which impact is felt beyond the shores of Africa today.
